The Anglican Holy Cross Church in

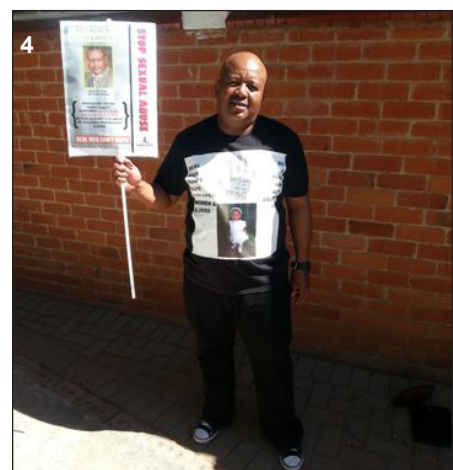
Phahameng heeded the Mayor's appeal which urged for "Churches must reclaim their places in Society".
