he city of Mangaung, in partnership with a number of Bloemfontein-based bikers groups, held a clothing run on Saturday, 08 November, which collected clothing items towards the metro's clothing bank.

The clothing bank was initiated by the Executive Mayor, Cllr. Thabo Manyoni, on 18 July 2013, with the intention to assist disadvantaged families who cannot afford clothing. The Executive Mayor and MMC for Social Services Cllr. Maditaba Matsoetlane had earlier this year encouraged both employees and residents in general to drop off clothing items at the branded bins which were placed at various points like Mahungra Car Wsh, Bram Fischer Building foyer, Twin City Mall and Kenworth Spar amongst others.

The bins were collected on Saturday, where some of the clothing items were handed over to beneficiaries from Iphahamiseng Orphanage Home in Batho Location.

The run was supported by Free State Presidents Council (FPC), Motorcycle Association of Central Area (MACA), Star Riders and CC Riders Bloemfontein.







The clothing run started at Mahungra Car Wash, and went on to collect the branded bins at Twin City Mall, Kenworth Spar and Rocklands Regional Office. The proceedings ended at Rose Garden Loch Logan, where the official handover of the items was done.
