Matobako further announced that the Dr J S Moroka Games are going to be held during March this year in Thaba Nchu in honour of the freedom fighter and the late ANC stalwart, Dr JS Moroka.

The Sports Federations which attended the meeting said that they appreciate the fact that the Executive Mayor councillor Thabo Manyoni has assigned the Sports and Youth portfolio to a young and energetic MMC to drive sports in Mangaung.
