- iv. Unless expressly otherwise determined, a Councillor may speak only once on a matter; (Rule 32)
- v. No speech shall exceed **five (5) minutes** in length without the consent of the Speaker. (Rule 34.1)

REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT POLICY FOR THE QUARTER ENDING DECEMBER 2016

1. BACKGROUND

It is the responsibility of each Municipality to have and implement supply chain management policy which gives effect to the legislative mandate.

The Accounting Officer of the Municipality must at the end of the quarter submit the report to the Mayor and annually to the Council on the implementation of the Municipal supply chain management policy.

This report covers the period of october to december 2016 and was prepared in line with the Municipal supply chain management policy as well as Municipal Finance Management Act No. 56 of 2003, in relation to the implementation of Municipal supply chain management policy.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to assist Council to maintain oversight over the implementation of its supply chain management policy in line with regulation six (6) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations.

3. ESTABLISHMENT OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT UNIT

The Municipality has established supply chain management unit in line with its supply chain management policy, Municipal supply Chain management regulations and Municipal Finance Management Act No. 56 of 2003.

Based on the approved staff establishment, the unit is having 80 positions, currently 49 (61%) positions are filled, of which 31 (39%) positions are vacant.

The supply chain management unit is fully functional and delivering its statutory mandate as prescribed by the National Treasury. In addition to the current human capital, three (3) unemployed graduates are currently designated at SCM unit to gain experiential training.

4. TRAINING OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT OFFICIALS

Thirty (30) supply chain management officials were enrolled with the training provider in order for them to meet minimum competency level in line with the minimum competency regulations as issued by the National Treasury, which was completed on 30 April 2016. Thirteen (13) remaining officials will be enrolled in the second round of the training.

5. LIST OF ACCREDITED PROSPECTIVE SERVICE PROVIDERS

An advertisement was placed in newspapers circulated both locally and nationally on the 04 May 2016, inviting prospective service provider to apply for listing into the Municipal Supply Chain Management database of prospective service providers / suppliers and is updated on daily basis.

6. PROCUREMENT PLANS

All Municipal Departments submitted demand plans and such plans were consolidated into an annual procurement plan and approved by the Accounting Officer.
