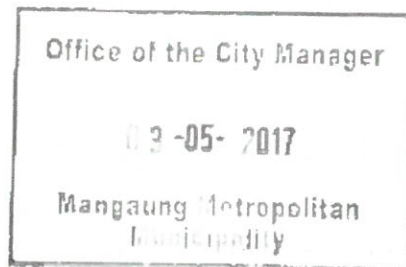

**MOTION TO BETTER SERVICE DELIVERY AND UPGRADE INFRASTRUCTURE IN
MANGAUNG METRO**

Your motion in the above matter refers.

Herewith are the responses to the issues raised in your motion.

1. CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA NO. 108 OF 1996 152.

Objects of local government. The objects of local government are-

- To provide a democratic and accountable government for local communities;
- To insure the provision of services to communities in a sustainable manner;
- To promote social and economic developments;
- To promote a safe and healthy environment; and
- To encourage the involvement of communities and community organisation in the matters of local government.

2. The 30 days payment of contractors.

MMM pays all its contractors within 30 days of issue of the invoice. The only instances where there maybe delays is when the paper-work from the Directorates may have problems that must be fixed or corrected.

3. The 30 days payment of sub-contractors by contractors.

MMM does not deal directly with the sub-contractors. However, if there are challenges with main contractors paying the sub-contractors, the Municipality does intervene and ensure that they are duly paid.

4. Published service level agreements for contractors and sub-contractors.


Please be advised that the publication of these service level agreements is not a requirement. However, should any Councillor wish to peruse any such agreement, you are always welcomed to contact the CFO for assistance.

5. Monitored performance management for all Mangaung Metro officials, contractors and sub-contractors

For officials, the following mechanisms are in place for performance management, firstly, this is done in line with SDBIP reports to track performance and achievement of key performance objectives. Secondly, monthly reports in terms of Section 71 of the MFMA. Thirdly, the mid-term reports in line with Section 72 of the MFMA. Again the Section 41 of the Municipal Systems Act provides for auditing of performance by AG. Lastly, Section 46 of the Systems Act provides for preparation of the Annual Report.

For contractors, the Municipality has contract management unit in place in Supply Chain Management and together with Directorates and project managers, they are responsible to monitor the performance of contractors.
