EM SIYONZANA MEETS WITH SENIOR MANAGEMENT

angaung Metro Executive Mayor, Cllr. Mxolisi Siyonzana called an introductory meeting with the city's Heads of Departments and General Managers to talk about issues affecting employees and the residents of Mangaung. The extended Mayoral Committee meeting was held at the Indaba Auditorium on Monday, September 13. Speaking to senior management, Siyonzana said there is an urgent need to accelerate services, mainly the filling of potholes, the cleanliness of the city, sewer spillages and ensuring uninterrupted water supply.

"I am concerned about the cleanliness of our city; we need to do the groundwork and ensure that our city is clean. I'm calling on all of us to ensure that we play our part and make a difference in the lives of the people that we serve. We have a long road ahead of us; but by working together and dealing away with the issue of working in silos, we can achieve greater things in our City," said Siyonzana.

Thomas Mkaza, the leader of the provincial intervention team, says it is important that EM Siyonzana spoke to the issue of the flow of reports in the municipality. In the meeting, the Executive Mayor reminded officials that all reports must go to the Office of the Executive Mayor before they go to Section 80,

Mkaza went on to emphasis the importance of the Executive Management Team (EMT) working as a team and



not individuals creating their own small teams.

A member of the intervention team, Luvuyo Ntoyi reported that the City has been in engagements with the Director-Generals of the departments of Human Settlement and National Treasury around some of the work that needs to be done in the City such as addressing issues of potholes, national roads that traverse through the municipality and addressing the issue of maintenance of roads that link to national roads such as the N1.

The Mayor called upon colleagues to rise to the occasion and focus on their areas of work, so that the city can deliver quality services to the residents of Mangaung. "I call upon senior management to stay away from politics and stick to their designated areas of work," he concluded.
