**Note by Secretariat**

1. **Attendance Register:** Every member attending a meeting shall sign his/her name in the attendance register kept for this purpose before the commencement of the meeting.
2. **Leave Register:** In order to streamline administrative processes Councillors are friendly requested to submit applications for leave of absence in the appropriate register kept for this purpose. Members are requested to fill in this register 12 hours before the commencement of the meeting (Rule 22.2) (Yellow Form).
3. **Name-plates:** Councillors are friendly requested to please take along their name-plates and to display it throughout the meeting.
4. **Apologies during the course of the Council meeting:** Councillors are friendly requested to complete in full and submit the relevant apology form for this purpose (Yellow Form).
5. **Code of Conduct:** Councillors are reminded of item 3, Schedule 1 of the Code of Conduct for Councillors which reads as follows, namely:

Attendance at Meetings: A councillor must attend each meeting of the municipal council and of a committee of which that councillor is a member, except when:

- (a) leave of absence is granted in terms of an applicable law or as determined by the rules and orders of the council or
- (b) that councillor is required in terms of this Code to withdraw from the meeting.

6. **Meeting rules:**
  - i. All Councillors must arrive at **least 15 minutes before the commencement** of the Council and all other Committee meetings;
  - ii. Cellular phones **must be in silent mode** and **speaking on a cellular phone during the meeting is prohibited**; (Rule 50.2a)
  - iii. A Councillor who speaks must **confine his or her speech strictly to the matter under discussion**; (Rule 31)
  - iv. Unless expressly otherwise determined, a Councillor **may speak only once on a matter**; (Rule 32)
  - v. No speech shall exceed **five (5) minutes** in length without the consent of the Speaker. (Rule 34.1)
  - vi. Council members are reminded to uphold high level of good conduct during Council proceedings (No disruptions, no interruptions, no howling, no swearing to other Council members, less movement in the Chamber, no abuse of the PA system).

OPENING**

The meeting commenced at 09h00.

The Speaker, to confirm the quorum, she read out loud the names of the Councillors to indicate their attendance. She confirmed that 82 Councillors were present in the meeting.

Councillor E Snyman van Deventer cautioned Councillors that even if the meeting was virtual, it was still a Council meeting and therefore Councillors should be dressed and conduct themselves properly.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE AGENDA**

The Speaker indicated that there was court order delivered by the High Court the previous day and Councillors might have heard on social media and therefore as an urgent matter it would affect the agenda.

She then read Rule 8.3 of the Standing Rules and Orders: *“For all urgent matters a threshold of majority of members present at the meeting should vote in favour of the urgent matter in order to be deliberated”*.

The Executive Mayor requested that the matter not be included in the agenda and it be referred to the next Special Council meeting and Councillor E Snyman Van Deventer agreed as the Council did not have documentation with regard to the court order.

The Deputy Executive Mayor, Council Whip, Councillor JE Sebolao, Councillor MC Lelala, Councillor PL Seleke all concurred with what the Executive Mayor had proposed.

Councillor D Leech stated that even though she agreed that the court case should not be discussed however Council should consider that as the Municipality did not currently have the City Manager.

The Executive Mayor reiterated that Councillors did not have documentation and as this was a special meeting and only one item on the agenda, the Council should stick to that i.e. dealing with only one item and he was seconded by Councillor PL Seleke who then proposed that the voting for the one item should be individually and not by block.

The Council Whip proposed for the adoption of the agenda as is and seconded by the Deputy Executive Mayor and further seconded individual voting.

Councillor M Davies indicated that the Council cannot function nor take decisions without the advice of the Municipal Manager whereon the Speaker explained that the Municipal Manager communicates with Council through the Executive Mayor as head of the executive.

The Councillors voted on approval of the agenda as is and the results are as follows: 58 in favour and 20 against.

After the announcement of the results, Councillor M Davies stated that it be noted that the DA voted against the agenda as is and to protect themselves from continuing with the unlawful Council meeting without the City Manager, they would be leaving the meeting.

The Executive Mayor stated that he received a message from Mr T Mkaza late the previous day regarding the outcome of the court judgement that need to be interpreted. That he was going to get the interpretation of the judgement which would then be discussed with whippers.

Furthermore, that the item discussed was just a nomination for SALGA conference and not a matter which needed advice from the City Manager.

**MANGAUNG DELEGATION TO ATTEND THE SALGA NATIONAL CONFERENCE 22 – 24 FEBRUARY 2022**

The Speaker presented the report as attached to the agenda.

Councillor MT Mosala proposed that recommendation b, be amended; that instead of the name of the Deputy Executive Mayor, Councillor MM Mothibi-Nkoane, it be replaced by the Council Whip, Councillor VE Nikelo as the office of the Mayor was already represented by the Executive Mayor and was seconded by Councillor KD Tshwane.

Councillor LJ Moqolo proposed that the recommendation be approved as is and Councillor CF Rampai seconded.

Other Councillors also supported both the proposals i.e. the amendment to recommendation (b) to include the name Council Whip, Councillor VE Nikelo as well as the recommendation as is, the Deputy Executive Mayor, Councillor MM Mothibi-Nkoane.

Councillor E Snyman Van Deventer stated that there was no need for individual votes, it should be on block and was supported by Councillor VE Nikelo.

Councillor MI Mokoakoa opposed the proposal by Councillor E Snyman Van Deventer and was supported by Councillor SQ Peter who stated that it should be individual as they had already started as such.

The Speaker then ruled that for the sake of consistency, the Council will continue with individual voting as they had already started with voting individually.

The Speaker put the recommendations to a vote and announced the results as follows:

**28 voted in favour of amendment, 25 against the amendment and 10 abstained**

Councillor JE Sebolao requested to change their vote from abstaining to the recommendation as is, however the Speaker stated that in terms of Rule 13 on the Standing Rules and Orders under decision and voting, that there was no provision for a Councillor to change the vote after the results were already announced. Further that the Councillor who changed her vote was prior to announcement of results.

It was thereupon

**RESOLVED**

- (a) that Council take note and approves of this report;
- (b) Mangaung Municipal Council nominate the Executive Mayor, Councillor Mxolisi Siyonzana; the Speaker, Councillor Stefani Lockman-Naidoo and **Council Whip, Councillor VE Nikelo** to attend the 2022, SALGA National Conference to be held at the Cape Town Convention Centre;
- (c) that the Executive Mayor, Councillor Mxolisi Siyonzana is entrusted with the voting rights on behalf of the municipality;
- (d) that feedback report on the outcomes of the National SALGA conference be provided to the Council within a period of two months after the event.
