### NOMINATIONS FOR SALGA FREE STATE PROVINCIAL WORKING GROUP MEMBERS

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this memo is to appraise the Municipal Council on the nomination processes of council members to serve in various SALGA Free State Provincial Working Groups.

### **DELIBERATIONS:**

We are members of the SALGA and Mangaung is the biggest municipality in the province, and therefore, expectation is very high regarding participation and contribution of Mangaung in the programs and activities of the association

SALGA's programs are driven through its working groups, whilst the National Executive Committee plays a crucial role in overseeing the overall activities of SALGA. The working groups act as the policy and strategic engine of the organisation and serve as an important platform for the communication and coordination between SALGA national, provinces and municipalities.

The main purpose of working groups is to encourage, ensure and promote local government matters which, include:

- Cooperative governance;
- · Consultation and coordination; and
- Participative decision-making.

The working groups, within their derived mandate, must develop policies, strategies and programmes to address critical local government issues.

Working groups serve as a forum through which organized local government can consult on a political level in order to contribute towards the creation of democratic and economically viable local government.

### Nomination process:

The nomination process for participation in the 14 working groups started during the month of May 2022, and proposed names are submitted to council for consideration and adoption.

The are two names per working group, first a member and secondly an alternate member, the purpose of the alternate, means a person appointed by the Council to act in the absence of member and has all the rights, responsibilities and obligations.

A total of 28 Councillors to serve and fully participate in this SALGA Free State Working Group is submitted and we further propose that a Hybrid System for meetings and engagements of working groups be instituted as some of the members will be from different municipal areas across the Free State Province.

- 1. Mangaung Metro Municipality supports SALGA initiatives of establishing 14 working groups across the vast landscape of our Free State Province;
