Mini Tornado hits informal settlement

Mamma ha Latwe informal settlement near Phase 6 in Bloemfontein was hard hit by a mini tornado that passed through the area on the evening of Friday, 4 March.

More than 15 shacks were affected and three children were injured and hospitalized as a result, at Pelonomi Hospital.

Residents said this is not the first time the area was affected by mini tornado, as it was also affected in early 2020.

Mampe Mosoen, whose shack was affected, said she was with her 5-year-old son when the tornado hit.

"I thought I was dreaming when my shack was blown away and hit my neighbours' shacks. I heard the rain and immediately covered my son," she said. At the time of going to print, Mangaung Metro Municipality was yet to respond on how they are going to assist the affected residents.
